



BOARD OF MEDICAL SPECIALTY CODING AND COMPLIANCE (BMSC) EXAM INFORMATION FOR TEST CENTER ADMINISTRATORS

General Information

There are four (4) exams in this program. General rules allow for test center issued scratch paper and test center issued pencil. Candidate cannot use any other writing instrument. Use of electronic devices is prohibited. Calculators are NOT allowed.

Check-In Requirements

- 1 unexpired Government-issued photo ID that bears the candidate's first and last name.
- 2nd form of ID required. Examples are: Credit Card, Library Card, Costco Card, etc.
- First and Last name on ID must match the name in the PSI system (for any discrepancies, use the Acceptable Names Discrepancy document to determine if the candidate's name variance will be permitted).
- Photo of candidate will **NOT** be taken.

Score Reports

Score report is issued at end of testing.

Exam Details

*Electronic code look-up systems are **NOT** allowed in the testing room. A hard copy coding manual is the **only** allowable resource. The hard copy coding manual may have commercially produced, pre-printed alpha tabs or tabular section dividers (A through Z) that are affixed. Post-It notes, loose papers or any other papers attached by any means are **NOT** allowed. You may have annotations written on the coding manual pages including the notes pages at the back of the manual but must be free of any notes containing coding rules and guidelines from other reference materials (for example, Coding Clinic, Home Health ICD-10-CM Coding Answers, and similar materials). The testing center staff (proctor) reserves the right to deny code books that contain excessive writing and information that may give the candidate an unfair advantage.
