

## **PSI EXAMINATION SITES OFFERING FINGERPRINTING**

(see CDI site fingerprint info below on page 2)

- PSI has fingerprint technicians available at these examination sites to assist California insurance license applicants to complete their fingerprint impression requirement.

Candidates will need to pay a fingerprint fee (\$68.95) that covers the following services:

- Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) processing fee of \$17
- Department of Justice (DOJ) processing fee of \$32
- Additional "rolling fee" charged by PSI of \$19.95

The \$68.95 fee is to be paid at the PSI test site. They accept money order, cashier's check, company check (made payable to MorphoTrust USA), VISA or MasterCard.

- Candidates will be asked at check-in if they want to complete fingerprinting.
- Candidates that decline fingerprinting on the day of their exam will not be permitted to return for fingerprinting as a walk-in and must schedule an appointment with L-1.
- PSI Test Centers do not handle "Walk-in appointments, for an appointment call (800) 315-4507
- When prints are taken, the candidate is given an ATI number
- The ATI number is at the bottom of their fingerprint paperwork.
- Prints are transmitted the day prints are taken
- Candidates will have to call MorphoTrust USA if they want more information (800) 315-4507.

## **CDI EXAMINATION SITES OFFERING FINGERPRINTING**

- CDI has its contracted fingerprint vendor, Accurate Biometrics, available at CDI's examination sites to assist California insurance license applicants to complete their fingerprint impression requirement.
- Candidates will need to pay a fingerprint fee (\$58.30) that covers the following services:
  - Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) processing fee of \$17
  - Department of Justice (DOJ) processing fee of \$32
  - Additional "rolling fee" charged by Accurate Biometrics of \$9.30
- The \$58.30 fee is to be paid directly to Accurate Biometrics. They accept money order,
- cashier's check, company check, personal check, VISA, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover.

Accurate Biometrics is also responsible for fingerprinting out-of-state applicants.

If you receive calls from CDI candidates regarding fingerprints, the candidates should be referred to the CDI web site for the most up to date fingerprinting information.

Also attached is the fingerprint form that lists the contact information for Accurate Biometrics on page 2.

This information will assist you in guiding out-of-state candidates to the correct fingerprint vendor.

If candidates want to get fingerprinted prior to taking their examination, these individuals should again be directed to the CDI web site to get information.
