


Pretest Items	In addition to the number of examination items specified, a small number of 5 to 10 “experimental” questions may be administered to candidates during the examinations. These questions will not be scored and the time taken to answer them will not count against examination time.

Remote Proctoring Notes	For candidates taking a remote proctored exam, they must log into their PSI UCS account to launch their exam. Have candidate refer to their CIB.
Splitting Portions	Exams with more than 1 portion, are mandatory and must be taken together. If a CD fails 1-portion and Passes the 2nd portion, they will then only take the failed portion.
Application Processing	Application Processor applies exam payments if they are mailed or faxed in. CD must be approved and imported from the education provider FIRST.

Name/Address Changes	This is a school import. <u>Never</u> instruct candidates to have their school send a new file. CSR can make minor changes such as correcting misspellings, adding/removing generation and middle names. Changes due to divorce/marriage - CD must send supporting documentation for Application Processor to enter. (Example: Divorce Decree for divorce, Marriage License for marriage)

Eligibility Criteria	Upon successful completion of the pre-license course requirements, your education provider will provied your eligibility electronically to PSI. Educator-approval or Agency-approval is not required to register or schedule a reactivation exam.

Reactivation Exam	A real estate licensee whose license has been inactive for two or more consecutive years must pass a reactivation exam to be eligible to reactivate the license. View the steps for reactivation, including required continuing education, on the Agency's website at www.oregon.gov/rea/licensing/Pages/Inactivate_Reactivate_License.aspx .

Fee	\$75 per exam combined or split portions
Payment Type	Pay by credit card, money order, company check or cashier’s check. Cash and personal checks are not accepted.
Reschedule Rules	You may cancel and reschedule an examination appointment without forfeiting your fee if your cancellation notice is received two days prior to the scheduled examination date.

<p>ADA/Exam Accommodation Approval</p>	<p>All PSI examination centers are equipped to provide access in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990, and exam accommodations will be made in meeting a candidate's needs.</p> <p>A candidate with a disability or a candidate who would otherwise have difficulty taking the examination must follow the link and instructions on the Exam Accommodations Request page at the end of the Candidate Information Bulletin.</p> <p>You are required to submit documentation from the medical authority or learning institution that rendered a diagnosis. Verification must be uploaded to PSI on the letterhead stationery of the authority or specialist and include the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Description of the disability and limitations related to testing • Recommended accommodation/modification • Name, title and telephone number of the medical authority or specialist • Original signature of the medical authority or specialist <p>DO NOT SCHEDULE YOUR EXAMINATION UNTIL THIS DOCUMENTATION HAS BEEN RECEIVED AND PROCESSED BY PSI ACCOMMODATIONS.</p>
<p>Out of State Testing</p>	<p>PSI has examination centers in many other regions across the United States. You may take this examination at any of these locations by submitting the Out-Of-State Request Form found in the back of the Candidate Information Bulletin.</p> <p>*You may email your out-of-state request to OutofStateRequest@psionline.com.</p> <p>DO NOT SCHEDULE YOUR EXAMINATION UNTIL THIS DOCUMENTATION HAS BEEN RECEIVED AND PROCESSED BY PSI ACCOMMODATIONS.</p>
<p>Test Center or Remote Proctoring</p>	<p>Please also make note that candidates will be able to take the OR RE exams at a test center or via remote proctoring. When scheduling candidates you will be able to select the option the candidate wants.</p>
	
	<p>If the candidate selects Remote online proctoring you will need to select Country and time zone before proceeding to selecting a test date.</p>
	
<p>Paper/Pencil</p>	<p>Yes</p>
<p>Bring to test center</p>	<p>You must provide one form of identification. The identification must be a VALID form of government issued identification (driver's license, state ID, passport, military ID), which bears your signature and your photograph. Also acceptable is an interim state driver's license card or an interim state ID card.</p>
	<p>A Military ID will not be accepted for a <u>remotely proctored exam</u>, however, all other types of Identification noted above are acceptable for this delivery mode.</p>
<p>Open Book Exam</p>	<p>No - Exams are CLOSED BOOK.</p>
<p>Calculator Allowed</p>	<p>Only non-programmable calculators that are silent, battery-operated, do not have paper tape printing capabilities, and do not have a keyboard containing the alphabet will be allowed in the examination site.</p>
<p>Reference Materials Given at Site</p>	<p>Proctor will hand-out an Amortization Table for Broker exams.</p>
<p>Passing Score</p>	<p>A score of 75% is required to pass all real estate examinations. For examinations with state and national sections, you must score 75% or better on both sections to successfully pass the entire exam.</p>

Score reports	<p>Score will be given to the candidate immediately, on-screen, following completion of the examination. The candidate will receive their score report via email, within 1-3 business days.</p> <p>Your score will be sent electronically to the state.</p>
Dup Score Report Fee	Free by mail (5 to 7 business days), \$40 expedited fee (2 - 3 business days)
Fingerprint Info	<p>ALL new license candidates must be fingerprinted for the purpose of conducting a state and national criminal history record search.</p> <p>You will be fingerprinted at the PSI exam center after passing the exam. The fingerprinting fee of \$56.25 is paid directly to PSI at the exam site to cover \$41.25 Oregon State Police and \$15 PSI processing fees. PSI accepts Visa, MasterCard, money orders, cashier's checks, and company checks.</p> <p>The prints are forwarded electronically to the appropriate review agencies.</p> <p>Note: Fingerprint processing may take up to 4 weeks.</p> <p>You <u>do not need to be fingerprinted if:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ You are an existing Oregon real estate licensee. ▪ You are taking the reactivation exam. ▪ You are a current Oregon broker attempting to become a principal broker.
Licensing instructions	<p>All questions and requests for information about licensure should be directed to the Oregon Real Estate Agency.</p> <p>The instructions on how to get a real estate license in Oregon are available on the Oregon Real Estate Agency's website at www.oregon.gov/rea.</p>
Retest fee	\$75 per exam combined or split portions
Retest procedure	<p>Candidates may take examinations on an unlimited basis. If you fail any portion of the exam, you must wait until the next day to schedule a retake exam appointment.</p> <p>The examination fee is valid for one exam attempt. If you fail, you may retake the examination after rescheduling and paying another fee to PSI.</p> <p>Broker and Principal Broker Applicants. If you pass only one section of the Broker or Principal Broker License examination, you are only required to retake the failed section. The score for the section passed is valid for 12 months; if the other section of the examination is not passed by then, both sections of the exam must be retaken.</p>
Exam review	<p>PSI, in cooperation with the Oregon Real Estate Agency, consistently evaluate the examinations administered to ensure that they accurately measure competency in the required knowledge areas.</p> <p>While taking the examination, you will have the opportunity to provide comments on any questions by clicking on the Comment button. Any comment you make will be analyzed by PSI examination development staff. PSI does not respond individually regarding these comments; however, all substantive comments are reviewed. This is the only review of examination materials available to candidates.</p>
